COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This conference is designed to provide a wide variety of topics within the fields of speech-language pathology and audiology. Each individual attending the conference will choose from topic presentations set in 1.5-hour blocks in 3 different tracks: Educational track; Medical track and Multi-Interest track. (The exception will be one course that is 2 hours long and will be a combined topic of ethics along with Legislative updates from CSHA Board members. This is to provide the ability to meet the ethics continuing education requirement through the American Speech-Language Hearing Association). Each session is designed independently by the presenter(s) and may include lecture, as well as interactive learning. Learning level varies from Introductory to Advanced. This conference is designed to provide information and practical application to speech-language pathologists and audiologists.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Upon completion of this course, the learner will be able to:

1. Identify practical strategies for use in their daily therapy sessions with their clients, for both adults and children receiving services from speech-language pathologists and audiologists.
2. Implement effective assessment strategies for all clients (pediatric & adult) served in speech-language pathology and audiology.
3. Develop a plan for sharing their newly acquired knowledge with colleagues, parents and clients in their primary work setting.
